## Command line arguments

#### Overview

Cw\_http.exe is the executable file that brokers communication between a user's browser and and the RESTful API used by the CAREWare 6 business tier cw\_bt.exe.

In most cases, cw\_http.exe is installed as a Windows service when the CAREWare 6 application installer is run, but cw\_http is capable of independently installing, stopping, and removing itself as a Windows service using command line arguments. It also has the ability to run in a Windows command window.

#### Using cw\_http.exe from a command window

Open a command window with administrative privileges and navigate to the directory where cw\_http.exe was installed.

Enter cw\_http and you should see the following output:

```
usage: cw_http <command>
```

where <*command*> is one of these: install, remove, debug, start, stop, pause or continue.

To use a command line argument, enter *cw\_http*, press the spacebar, type the command line argument (like *install*), and then press the enter key.

The rest of this document describes what each command line argument does.

#### install

Installs cw\_http.exe as a windows service under the name CAREWare HTTP Service.

#### remove

Removes cw\_http.exe from Windows services.

#### debug

Runs cw\_http.exe indefinitely. Ctrl+C or closing the command window will stop it.

#### stop

Stops the CAREWare HTTP Service.

### pause or continue

Not used.
